b.	<b>33 hours</b> in studio courses, including Art Studio 106, <b>Drawing I</b> ; 121, <b>Two-Dimensional Design</b> ; and 122, <b>Three-Dimensional Design</b> ; also required are two courses with one chosen from: 130, <b>Introduction to Electronic Art</b> ; 187, <b>Introduction to Photography</b> ; 205, <b>Drawing II</b> ; 207, <b>Painting I</b> ; 274, <b>Introduction to Printmaking</b> ; and the other chosen from: 157, <b>Small Scale Metal Construction I</b> ; 168, <b>Introduction to Ceramics (Ceramics I)</b> ; 213, <b>Sculpture I</b> ; and 9 hours upper division.	<u>33 hours</u> <b>48 hours</b>
