Statistics:	Math 145	3 hrs
Nutrition:	Nutr 244	3 hrs
Psychology:	Must include: Developmental Psychology - Psych 220	6 hrs

Pass/Fail (CR/NC) options are not acceptable for any of the courses listed under Sciences. Candidates with academic records with an overall or science grade-point average of less than 3.0 on a four-point scale will not be considered. Grades of D or F are not acceptable towards fulfilling prerequisites. Advance level courses may be credited towards the science GPA if the basic requirements have been fulfilled.
