WHAT IS 3-2 MBA PROGRAM It's an early start MBA program designed for NON-MANAGEMENT students to get admittance to the MBA program during their undergrad, take up to 6 MBA classes during their senior year, and use those 6 classes toward both an MBA and a minor for their undergrad.

SAMPLE TIMELINE

UNDERGRADUATE

- First 3 Years student pursues undergraduate non-mgmt degree (AT LEAST 90 CREDITS COMPLETED)
Recommend that student completes Calculus and Microeconomics (not required)
- 1st Sem Junior student studies and takes GMAT or GRE exam (TAKE A PREP COURSE/PRACTICE TEST)
- 2nd Sem Junior student's major requirements are near completion
student applies to MBA program + submits 3-2 Supplemental Application
Must have no more than 30 credit hours left to complete, including 18 minor credits if needed
- 1st Sem Senior student takes 3 MBA core classes* + 1-2 UG classes (3-2 students have special MBA sections)
*Must get level restriction form signed by Anderson Graduate Advisor to take grad level classes
- 2nd Sem Senior student takes 3 MBA core classes + 1-2 UG classes (3-2 students have special MBA sections)
*Must get level restriction form signed by Anderson Graduate Advisor to take grad level classes

GRADUATION: Student must contact Erick Rodriguez (erodriguez@unm.edu) to switch to Graduate status.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

- 1-2 Years 19-25 credits left to finish MBA program (19 if Accelerated MBA, 25 if Focused MBA)

MINOR/ELECTIVE INFORMATION

IF Minor Requirement in Major: Student will receive a minor in MGMT for taking 6 MBA classes. Grades applied to UG.

IF No Minor Requirement in Major: Student will receive elective credit for take 6 MBA classes. Grades applied to UG.
