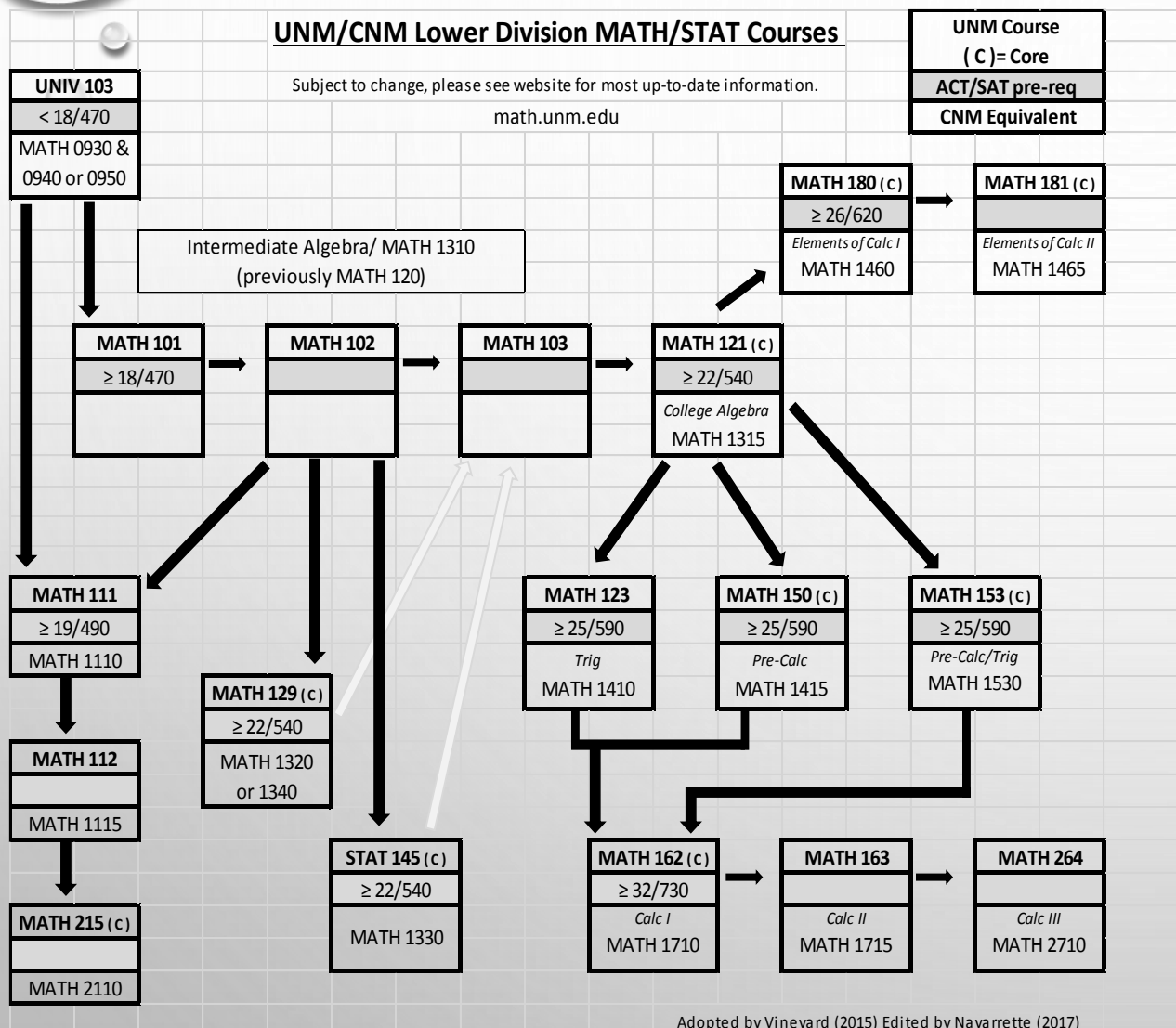

WAITLIST (100 – 600 LEVEL): STUDENTS EMAIL/SPEAK WITH THE INSTRUCTOR FOR A WAITLIST OVERRIDE

- CAPACITY OVERRIDES ARE ONLY PROCESSED BY THE INSTRUCTOR IF...
- 1) THE WAITLIST SYSTEM IS OFF FOR THE SEMESTER 2) THE INSTRUCTOR HAS PHYSICAL ROOM & WOULD NOT BE VIOLATING FIRE MARSHAL CAPACITY 3) THE INSTRUCTOR HAS THE TIME TO TAKE ON MORE STUDENTS THAN OBLIGATED TO TEACH THAT SEMESTER 4) THE STUDENT HAS BEEN ATTENDING THE CLASS

1. CREDIT NOT ALLOWED FOR BOTH MATH 162 AND 180.
2. CREDIT NOT ALLOWED FOR BOTH MATH 163 AND 181.
3. CREDIT NOT ALLOWED FOR BOTH MATH 314 AND 321.
4. CREDIT NOT ALLOWED FOR BOTH MATH 401 AND 501.
5. CREDIT NOT ALLOWED FOR BOTH MATH 322 AND 422.
6. STUDENTS WHO HAVE CREDIT FOR ANY COURSES NUMBERED MATH 121 AND ABOVE MAY NOT TAKE MATH 101 - 103 FOR CREDIT.
7. STUDENTS WHO HAVE CREDIT FOR ANY COURSES NUMBERED 162 AND ABOVE MAY NOT TAKE MATH 101-103, 121, 123 OR 150 FOR CREDIT. (STUDENTS WITH MATH 180/181 MAY TAKE MATH 123 FOR CREDIT).
8. STUDENTS WHO HAVE CREDIT FOR ANY COURSES NUMBERED MATH 121 OR ABOVE MAY ALSO TAKE MATH 129 AND/OR STAT 145.
9. A STUDENT MAY NOT TAKE AN EXAMINATION TO VALIDATE CREDIT IN MATHEMATICS COURSES EXCEPT THOSE OFFERED THROUGH UNM TESTING CENTER.
10. MATHEMATICS OR STATISTICS COURSE WORK DATING BACK MORE THAN FIVE YEARS CANNOT AUTOMATICALLY BE COUNTED AS FULFILLMENT OF A PREREQUISITE. STUDENTS WITH OLDER COURSE WORK WHO FEEL THEY HAVE RETAINED SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE THE PLACEMENT EXAM OFFERED THROUGH THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO TESTING CENTER.



- ❖ CNM's new Math 153 (Math 1530) course. Glenda has made corrections for Math 1530 count in the audit but it will not show up on TES yet.
- ❖ MATH 1210: Methods of Problem solving (formerly called Math 119, which has no equivalent at UNM).
 - ❖ Students who have successfully completed Math 1210 at CNM and have not completed other Math/Stat college level courses can either take the Placement Exam (UNM Testing Center) or can email advisor@math.unm.edu to request an override for Math 129 and/or Stat145.

- **MATH 121 (2ND HALF IN THE MALL)**

- STUDENTS WHO COMPLETE MATH 101-103 IN THE 1ST HALF OF THE SEMESTER ARE GIVEN PRIORITY FIRST.
- IF THERE IS ROOM THOSE WHO HAVE TAKEN MATH 103 1ST HALF MAY BE ABLE TO GET INTO THE COURSE BUT IT IS NOT GUARANTEED.
- REASONING: MATH 121 2ND HALF IS A CONDENSED AND FAST PACED ENVIRONMENT COMPARED TO ALEK (SELF-PACED). PLEASE USE YOUR BEST “ADVISOR” JUDGMENT WITH REFERRING STUDENTS TO THE INSTRUCTOR. PERMISSION REQUIRED IS STILL ATTACHED TO MATH 121 2ND HALF.

- **INSTRUCTOR PERMISSION: STUDENTS EMAIL THE INSTRUCTOR FOR PERMISSION**

- ACCUPLACER

- ✓ **ACCUPLACER:** A STUDENT MAY **RETAKE** THE MATH TEST FOUR (4) TIMES.
 - ✓ MUST BE TAKEN BEFORE THEY START THEIR MATH SEQUENCING AND BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS
- ✓ **TEST SCORES...SOATEST:** HIGHEST USED FOR PLACEMENT (NOT NECESSARILY MOST RECENT)
 - ✓ ***WHEN A STUDENT HAS A QUESTION ABOUT A DEADLINE...
