Common Course Numbering

The State of New Mexico requires that most 100- and 200- level courses across all institutions of higher learning share common course numbers CCNS). The goal is to see student, like similar statutes in other states, transfer between institutions and thus completion of degrees. In 2015 at statewide project aligned courses across all institutions of higher learning by subject matter on the basis of shared student learning outcomes (SLOs) identified by educators. 100- and 200-level courses received four-cluid common course numbers CCNOs) and subject codes.




Increase in Retention and Graduation Rates
