Indicators to encourage some self-exploration:

- They do not know what to major in
- Failing foundational courses for their major
- Cannot get accepted into their major program
- Uninterested in or dislike courses related to their major
- Uninterested in/apathetic toward all courses
- Unmotivated for college in general
- Told to come to college, no personal goal
- Have scattered interests or are taking courses in seemingly unrelated fields
- Highly successful in courses unrelated to their major but not in courses for their major

Questions to ask students:

- What drew you to your current major?
- What is it you like best about your major or career path?
- What do you know about _____ (career you are pursuing)?
- How much experience do you have with
 _____ (career you are pursuing)?
- What is your dream job?
 If you could do any job in the world, no holds or obstacles, what would it be?
- What would a day look like in your dream job?
