

New Student Orientation (NSO) Branch Transition Students

What are my options?

Option 1: Branch Online Orientation

An asynchronous session you complete on your own, on your own time.

Option 2: Branch Plus

Complete the Branch Online Orientation and advisement first to unlock registration. Then attend an in-person orientation at a later date.

When should I sign up?

After admission to UNM ABQ, starting on the following dates:

Spring Admission:

Oct 10 @ 10 AM (10/10 @ 10)

Summer/Fall Admission:

Feb 2 @ 2 PM (2/2 @ 2)

How to Sign-Up for and Complete NSO:

Log Into the Reservation Portal

Go to nso.unm.edu and click on the turquoise button labeled, "Orientation Reservation and Task List."

Complete & Confirm Academic Information:

Here you can confirm or change your major, express interest in the Honors College, and let us know about any additional outside test scores or coursework you have not yet already provided to UNM.

Choose an NSO

Select from Option 1 or 2 described above

4

Complete the following sections:

- **Accessibility** - Identify students seeking accommodations at NSO and as UNM ABQ students (e.g. service animal, ASL interpreter, etc)
- **Questionnaire** - This section gathers background information to connect students with appropriate campus resources.
- **Find Your Pack** - This section lets students request connections to campus resources and support communities.

Review Refund Policy & Make Payment

You can pay with a credit card or you can charge it to your student account.

Complete Your Task List:

- The final online module will become available to complete about one week before registration week.
- Once all items on the task list are complete, your NSO hold will come off within the next 24-48 hours.
